BEET BORSCHT

INGREDIENTS:

4 medium roasted red beets, peeled and chopped
1 medium sweet potato, peeled and chopped
2 leeks' whites, rinsed and chopped
1 medium yellow onion, chopped
3 quarts chicken stock
1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
1/4 teaspoon nutmeg
Salt and white pepper to taste
1 cup heavy cream
Sour cream to garnish

METHOD:

- In a stock pot, combine beets, sweet potato, leeks and onion with chicken stock and bring to a boil over high heat.
- Reduce heat to simmer and cook until beets soften.
- · Season with cinnamon, nutmeg, salt and white pepper.
- Using an immersion blender, puree until smooth; or puree in batches using a food processor, then return to pot to reheat.
- Stir in heavy cream.
- Serve in crocks, or small deep bowls, and garnish with a dollop of sour cream.
